New Business:

A sign would have to be put up for the public also. The owners are planning on having their application submitted by next week.

Cheryl Sams reported approximately 20 vendors had signed up for Heritage Days but there were no sponsors yet. Reminder letters are going to be sent out. Some of the needs for the Heritage Days had been taken care of such as port-a-potties and the road sign.
