Rules and Regulations from the Town of Talking Rock:

1. The Town of Talking Rock and the Talking Rock Bronco Stampede Committee and all persons, property owners, suppliers, volunteers, or entities connected with the Talking Rock Bronco Stampede are not liable for damages, injury or loss to any persons or goods from any cause whatsoever. All vendors, their heirs, administrators, and executors hereby waive and release all the above named from all claims or damages.

2. All vendors participating in the Talking Rock Bronco Stampede shall comply with the sanitary rules and regulations of Pickens County and Georgia's Health Department. All food must be properly displayed, fresh, grown, prepared and packaged in accordance with all local, state and federal regulations.

3. Vendors must have their booth(s) set up for the entire festival, Saturday, June 6, 2026.

Failure to do so could result in not being invited back next year. (exceptions made for illness, injury, or emergency) ** please reach out to discuss alternative arrangements if you cannot meet this schedule

a. Friday check-in will be allowed and additional details on set up time will be shared by May 15th (or sooner). All vehicles must be detached and removed from the vendor space – parking will be designated accordingly.

b. Saturday Schedule: Vendor Village opens at 8am. The event concludes at 9pm. The success of the Talking Rock Bronco Stampede depends on maintaining a vibrant and fully operational vendor area throughout the event. To protect the attendee experience and overall event flow, the Event Team will determine the official tear-down start time. This determination will be based on attendance, weather, safety, traffic patterns, and other operational factors. Vendors must remain set up until clearance is given by event staff. Early breakdown without approval may impact participation in future Town of Talking Rock events. We appreciate your partnership in creating an exceptional experience for our community and guests.

c. Food Vendors: Food vendors must have food trucks/trailers/tents/tables in place by event opening time Saturday morning, 8am. However, food vendors may open no later than 11am Saturday.

4. Vendors are responsible for setting up booths and providing their own supplies, i.e., tables, tents, chairs.

5. Vendors are responsible for cleaning their assigned areas.

6. The Talking Rock Events Committee will approve all vendors, and the same type of food offerings will be limited.

7. Vendors' space will be assigned by the Committee (Special requests will be considered but not guaranteed).

8. No refunds will be made after May 1, 2026; (There will be a \$50.00 charge for NSF checks).
